Elisha House is offering two Biblical Healing Groups in September, 2017. Leaving Yesterday Behind on Thursdays from 9:30-11:30am, starting September 14th and ending November 30th; and, Overcoming Fear and Anxiety on Tuesdays from 7:00-9:00pm, starting September 19th and ending November 21st.

**Leaving Yesterday Behind:** 'Most of us are not unfamiliar with "baggage" - the stuff of the past that we have not really dealt with which we carry into our relationships. This study helps the participant to focus upon those attitudes which perpetuate yesterday's problem. Using William Hines' book *Leaving Yesterday Behind: A Victim No More*, we will demonstrate how to use biblical tools that transform our broken thinking into God's thinking to break free of these debilitating characteristics.'

**Overcoming Fear and Anxiety:** 'Racing thoughts, wired bodies, uncertainty about the future. At some point in all of our lives we experience worry, anxiety and fear. Each one of us wants to find peace - peace from the thoughts, nagging concerns & the physical symptoms of anxiety. In this group we will seek to view our anxieties as opportunities to get to know God better and find Him as the God of Peace. We will also be taking some practical steps to address our fears by 'drilling down' into three common fear themes: fear of man, money, and death. We will be working through the workbook *When I Am Afraid* by Ed Welch, as well as other related articles.'
