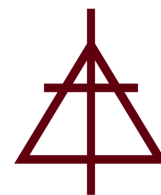

Prayer Walk Niagara Falls Church Plant

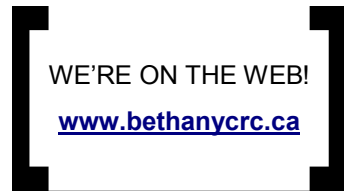
