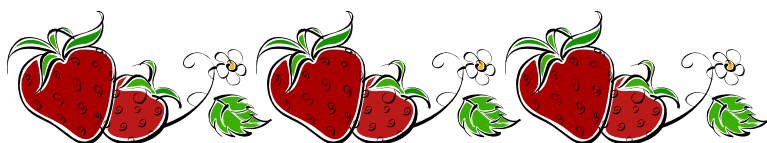

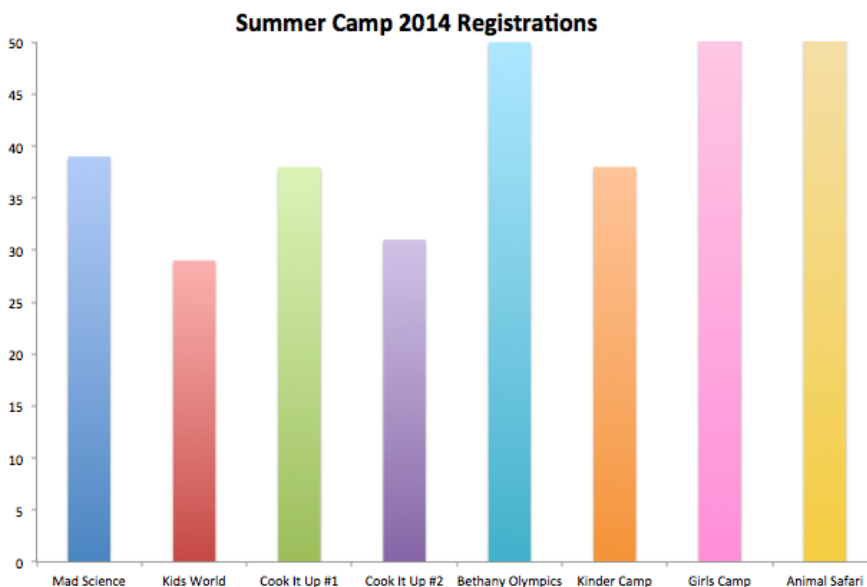
REDEEMER UNIVERSITY COLLEGE
