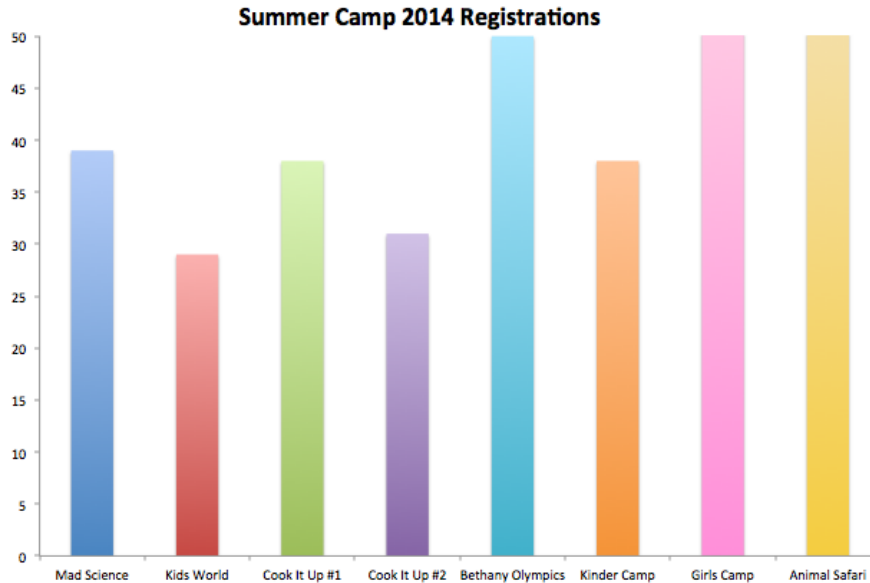
REDEEMER UNIVERSITY COLLEGE
